**LOCAL ARTIST'S ACCESS RESIDENCE (LAAR)**

The Local Artist's Access Residence (LAAR) program provides forty hours of free access to film, digital, or video labs, two days rental of film/video production equipment to artists in the Buffalo/Erie County region, \$100 towards materials and one free workshop at Squeaky Wheel. Past local artists selected to participate in LAAR include Anna Chiaretta, Mark Longolucco, Jax Deluca, Andrew Wurl, Kerrie Hopkins, Siew-wai Kok, Brian Milbrand, Eve Heller, Joanna Raczynska, John Logan, Monique Askew, Sonia Malfa, Jan Nagle, Gail Gorman, Temenuga Trifonova, Josh Strauss, Courtney Grim, Carolyn Tennant and Caroline Koebel.

The selected artists notified will be notified June 30, 2008 and may fulfill the terms of the residency between September 15, 2008 and February 15, 2009. Works must be completed by February 15 for the LAAR screening in Spring 2009. Please note that this is a local equipment access residency – no stipends are available for out of town residents.

- LAAR artists are required to complete proposed work five months after accepting the residency and to exhibit completed in the LAAR screening. Students are ineligible to apply.
- Application deadline is June 16, 2008. Notification is June 30, 2008.

- Complete application includes resume/biography, work sample (on vhs, svhs, mini-dv, or 16mm/Super 8 film), and two-page application form. Include a SASE if you wish to have your submission returned to you.
